Q: Do you know how much one bottle of change can hold?

A: Pennies only averages about \$7.00; mixed coins averages about \$35.00



Q: Who can get help from Miles Perret Cancer Services (MPCS)?

A: Anyone (any age) diagnosed with cancer who lives or receives treatment within the 10-parish service area.



Q: Can you name one of the services MPCS provides for clients?

A: We offer wigs, hats, scarves, mastectomy items, patient navigation notebooks, support groups, medical supplies, family events, resource library, nutritional supplements, and Wellness Center.



Q: How does MPCS offer FREE help to those with cancer?

A: Because people like you collect change and people in the community sponsor and participate in our fundraising events.



Q: What kinds of activities can possibly prevent cancer?

A: Eating 5 fruits and vegetables a day, exercising daily, maintaining a healthy weight, and not smoking



Q: How many parishes does MPCS service?

A: We service 10 parishes: Acadia, Avoyelles, Evangeline, Iberia, Jeff Davis, Lafayette, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, and Vermilion



Q: Did you know that there is a color to represent almost every kind of cancer? What color represents lung cancer? Breast cancer?

A: White represents lung cancer. Pink represents breast cancer.
